

6TH HOLE BUNKER ADDITIONS & ALTERATIONS

Middle fairway bunker - We would like to close this bunker in and create a smooth gentle swale in this area which will be cut at fairway height. This bunker has deemed unpopular with many as it is both very penal and cannot be seen from the tee.

New fairway bunker on RHS - In order to keep the drive reasonably tight for a short par 5, a new fairway bunker further on down the RHS is proposed. This would be some 35-40 yards past the present fairway bunker and will pose a threat to the longer hitters who can easily avoid the first trap. A blue line indicating the proposed location and size will be painted onto the turf.

Bunker in the rough between 6th and 12th - It is proposed to return this bunker to a long splash bunker and add a little marram grass Island within it to give a little links feel to it.

New approach bunker LHS - It is proposed to remove the mound and reinstate this bunker to keep the approach to the green guarded and add challenge to the 2nd/3rd shot. Again this will be blue lined to highlight the intentions.

Bunker LHS of green - It is proposed to fill in this unpopular and unfair bunker and instead create a sunken grassed area 4-5ft deep that will provide a variety of testing options should you either end up in it or fall to the side or short of it.
