CONDITIONS

1. The competition will be 18 holes, Mixed **Greensomes** Stroke Play.
2. The competition is open to members of recognised golf clubs holding a handicap under the current **CONGU** Unified Handicapping System
3. The closing date for entry is at 09.00 on **Monday, 27th April 2020**
4. In the event of competitors having to scratch after the closing date the entry fee will not be refunded.
5. Competitors must conform to the Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the local rules of Fortrose & Rosemarkie Golf Club.
6. A competition handicap limit of **28** for Men and **36** for Ladies will apply. Competitors will then receive strokes based on half the combined handicaps of the **two** players with halves counting.

FOR EXAMPLE

Ladies Handicap = 24 + Gents Handicap = 9 = 33 Strokes divided by 2 = 16.5

7. **The Gents will play from White tees, Ladies from Red tees. The competition will be scored against the White Course Par and Stroke Index. Each player will tee off on each hole, select the best drive and then play alternatively until the hole is complete.**
8. Please put individual handicaps onto the scorecard and put your team handicap on the card before you sign it after the calculations have been made as explained in Point 6.
9. All ties will be decided by the last **9, 6, 3, 2, or 1** holes of the card.
10. Prizes will be awarded for the three leading scores in Scratch & Handicap [2 Sections].
11. All competitors are expected to attend the prize-giving.
12. All disputes shall be decided by the competition committee whose decision will be final.
13. Competitors must comply with any further conditions advised on the day of competition.
