# FORTROSE & ROSEMARKIE GOLF CLUB Update – Tuesday, 5<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2021



### **BOOKING TEE TIMES & GENERAL PLAY**

- <u>PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW VERY CAREFULLY GIVEN THE NEW RESTRICTIONS</u> <u>APPLICABLE FROM TUESDAY, 5<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2021</u>.
- Tee times will be available daily at 7 minute intervals.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> hole is the <u>only</u> starting hole on the course.
- Members <u>cannot</u> play unless they have a confirmed tee time. Members are requested not to turn up to the 1<sup>st</sup> tee without a prior booking being in place.
- Groups of up to <u>TWO</u> players can play together consisting of <u>TWO different households</u> whilst always maintaining social distancing guidelines. Please maintain a steady pace of play at all times and be aware of other players playing on the course.
- All bookings <u>MUST</u> be made online as everything else will be closed.
- For contact tracing purposes, <u>it is vital</u> that the Club has a complete record of those playing on any given day. When making a booking/reservation with <u>GUESTS</u> please ensure that you e-mail the name/s of your playing partner/s to the Club Secretary. If there are any changes to your booking, you <u>MUST</u> ensure that you amend your online booking accordingly, or inform the Club Secretary by e-mail <u>before</u> playing on the links.
- Juniors playing from a handicap of 18 or below can now play unaccompanied or with other members. Any other junior players aged 16+ who must have golf course experience are permitted to play on the course without being accompanied by another. All other Junior players <u>must</u> be accompanied by an adult of the same household.
- Members can book up to <u>FOUR</u> days in advance <u>ONLINE</u>.
- If you cannot make your tee time, <u>please cancel</u> as soon as possible so your own booking/reservation can then be used by another member if needed.
- The Clubhouse, Office, Catering Facility, Toilet Facilities and Pro Shop will <u>ALL</u> be <u>CLOSED</u>.
- Scorecards are available if needed from the Porch area to the back of the 18<sup>th</sup> Green as everything else will be off-limits.
- Bring your own hand sanitiser with you and use as needed.

## CAR PARKING

- The members and overspill car parks will be open. Please adhere to social distancing at all times when preparing for your round.
- Entry to the 1<sup>st</sup> tee is <u>via the pathway leading down to the old Pro Shop</u>.
- Please change in the car park prior to your round and make your way to the 1<sup>st</sup> tee and/or putting green area whilst maintaining social distancing guidelines.
- Clubs and trolleys are to be taken home after your round is complete as the clubhouse will remain be closed until further notice.

#### **BEFORE THE ROUND**

- Please respect social distancing standards at all times.
- Please bring a small bottle of hand sanitiser with you.



- Only the golf course and practice facilities will be open.
- Buggies will be available for hire for single use only but they <u>must</u> be booked in advance of your round and whilst having a significant reason for using one.
- Wait in your car <u>10</u> minutes before your round (or for those walking at a safe distance) and then walk to the first tee/putting green whilst observing strict two metre social distancing rules at all times.
- Access to the practice putting green is strictly from the path adjacent to the 1<sup>st</sup> tee.
- Practice on the putting green is allowed for you and your playing partner/s <u>only</u> prior to you teeing off from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee. Strict social distancing rules must be observed.
- The range/practice area will remain open but limited to a max. of SEVEN people.
- Do not enter the first tee until the group in front have played and vacated the teeing area and are walking down the 1<sup>st</sup> fairway.
- Tee off at exactly the tee time allocated to you or your group whilst always maintaining social distancing standards from your playing partner/s.
- A PDF of our scorecard is <u>attached</u> if needed for use at any time.

## DURING THE ROUND

- Golfers must maintain social distancing standards at all times on the golf course. Members of the public will be watching you so please respect the guidelines.
- There will be no water-dispensing on the course. On-course benches must not be used and the rubbish bins will be out of use so please take any rubbish home with you following your round of golf.
- There is a maximum 3 minutes to find a lost ball. <u>Play a provisional if in doubt</u>!
- Do not touch stray or other players' golf balls.
- All bunkers are in play, but rakes are removed. After playing your shot rake the sand with your club or foot. <u>A local rule has been introduced as you already know</u>.
- On greens, do not touch flagsticks which <u>MUST</u> be left in the hole at all times.
- Do not move to the next tee unless the group ahead have played and vacated the teeing area and are walking down the next fairway.

## AFTER THE ROUND

• Leave the course and return to the car park where you may have a vehicle, by passing the ladies' locker rooms to the left side of the clubhouse as you come off the 18<sup>th</sup> green. Leave the car park as soon as you can and maintain social distancing at all times.
