FORTROSE & ROSEMARKIE GOLF CLUB Update from Monday, 26th April 2021





GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Tee times will be available daily at 8 minute intervals.
- The 1st hole is the <u>ONLY</u> starting hole on the course for track and trace purposes.
- Members <u>CANNOT</u> play unless they have a confirmed tee time. Members are requested not to turn up to the 1st tee without a prior booking being in place.
- Groups of up to four players can play together consisting of up to <u>FOUR</u> different households whilst always maintaining social distancing guidelines. Please maintain a steady pace of play at all times and be aware of other players playing on the course.
- All bookings <u>MUST</u> be made online for track and trace purposes.
 - For contact tracing purposes, it is <u>vital</u> that the Club has a complete record of those playing on any given day. When making a booking/reservation with GUESTS please ensure that you e-mail the name/s of your playing partner/s to the <u>Club Secretary</u>. If there are any changes to your booking, you <u>MUST</u> amend your online booking accordingly, or inform the Club Secretary by e-mail before playing on the links.
- Juniors playing from a handicap of 18 or below can now play unaccompanied or with other members. Any other junior players aged 16+ who must have golf course experience are permitted to play on the course without being accompanied by another. All other Junior players <u>MUST</u> be accompanied by an adult.
- Members can book up to <u>FOUR</u> days in advance with bookings going live at 07.00.
- If you cannot make your tee time, <u>please cancel</u> it as soon as possible so your own booking/reservation can then be used by another member.
- The Pro shop and the Clubhouse will open up again from Monday, 26th April 2021. Rob Douglas will continue to offer lessons for members so please contact him direct on fargolfltd@gmail.com. The Chanterelle Restaurant will be providing breakfasts and meals internally from 10.00-15.00 all week and the Takeaway service will continue to operate on a Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 15.00-20.00. The bar will open up from 11.00 daily. There is to be no queuing at the bar – only one person at a time!
- Scorecards are available if needed from the Porch area to the back of the 18th Green, from the Pro Shop and from the Clubhouse.
- Please bring your own hand sanitiser with you and use as needed.

CAR PARKING & PREPARING FOR YOUR ROUND

- The members car park will be open as normal.
- Entry to the 1st tee is via the pathway leading down to the Pro Shop from the car park.
- Change in the car park 10-15 minutes prior to your round and make your way to the 1st tee and/or putting green area whilst maintaining social distancing guidelines.
- Clubs and trolleys are to be taken home after your round is complete as the locker rooms and trolley shed will remain be closed until further notice.

BEFORE THE ROUND

Please respect social distancing standards at all times.





- Please bring a bottle of hand sanitiser with you if possible.
- The toilet facilities in the clubhouse and in the new building will be open for use from Monday, 26th April 2021. Please use these facilities in a safe manner and please ensure that sanitise before and after use. <u>The on-course toilets will remain closed</u>.
- Buggies will be available for hire for single use only but they <u>MUST</u> be booked in advance of your round and whilst having a significant reason for using one.
- Wait in your car <u>10-15 minutes</u> before your round (or for those walking at a safe distance) and then proceed to the first tee/putting green whilst observing social distancing rules at all times.
- Access to the practice putting green is strictly from the path adjacent to the 1st tee.
- Practice on the putting green is allowed for you and your playing partner/s <u>only</u> prior to you teeing off from the 1st tee. Strict social distancing rules MUST be observed.
- The range/practice area will remain open but please follow the practice area guidelines as updated and now in place via the <u>HOME</u> page of the Club Website.
- <u>DO NOT</u> enter the first tee until the group in front have played and vacated the teeing area and are walking down the 1st fairway.
- Tee off at exactly the tee time allocated to you or your group whilst always maintaining social distancing from your playing partner/s. Players <u>MUST</u> record the player/s name/s against their allocated tee time when booking online.

DURING THE ROUND

- Golfers must maintain social distancing standards at all times on the golf course.
 Members of the public will be watching so please respect the guidelines.
- There will be no water-dispensing on the course. On-course benches <u>SHOULD NOT</u> be used to sit on. Rubbish bins will be in use so please put all of your rubbish in the bins that are provided and <u>DO NOT</u> leave empty bottles lying about on the course.
- There is a maximum 3 minutes to find a lost ball. <u>Play a provisional if in doubt</u>!
- Do not touch stray or other players' golf balls.
- All bunkers are in play, but rakes are removed. After playing your shot rake the sand with your club or foot. <u>A local rule has been introduced</u>.
- On greens, <u>DO NOT</u> touch, the flagsticks which <u>MUST</u> be left in the hole at all times.
- Do not move to the next tee unless the group ahead have played and vacated the teeing area and are walking down the next fairway.
- If you are holding up play and you have lost a clear hole on the group in front, please let the group behind through!

AFTER THE ROUND

• The bar and catering facilities will be open for use. <u>FOLLOW</u> the guidelines and instructions which are clearly on display and respect the staff working there at all times. As a member of the Club you have a responsibility to follow the rules!
