PRACTICE AREA/RANGE GUIDELINES

FROM MONDAY, 26TH APRIL 2021



- The practice area/range is open to <u>MEMBERS, GUESTS AND VISITORS ONLY</u>. Rob Douglas (Professional) will also be using this area for the purpose of coaching/lessons.
- The maximum amount of people using the practice area/range at any one time will be limited to <u>10 PERSONS</u> whilst <u>ALWAYS</u> maintaining social distancing guidelines.
- <u>TWO</u> members are permitted to use the <u>short game</u> practice area at any one time whilst maintaining social distancing guidelines. No more than <u>SIX</u> members are permitted to use the <u>central area</u> at any one time whilst always maintaining social distancing standards and <u>TWO</u> members are permitted to use the area to the <u>right side</u> of the practice range whilst again maintaining social distancing guidelines.
- Please be aware that other members <u>MAY BE WAITING</u> to use the practice area if at capacity (10 persons) so we are kindly asking members to use the range for a maximum of one hour at any given time (this can be longer if no-one is waiting). The person who was there first should vacate this area first which will allow us to keep as many people as possible happy and to allow them to practice as required.
- The use of the ball machine and the use of the baskets <u>ARE NOW</u> permitted. Ball tokens can be purchased from the Pro Shop or Bar Area for £2.00 (40 golf balls). Hand sanitiser will be available for use beside the ball machine but we are also encouraging members to use their own hand sanitiser before and after use where possible.
- Where golfers are using their own golf balls for practice, they <u>MUST</u> be clearly marked with their own marking to prevent the need to touch another person's golf ball/s when collecting them. Please be respectful to other member/s at all times who may be collecting their own golf balls at any time from the range.
- The use of the practice nets to the <u>LEFT</u> and <u>RIGHT</u> side are available for use. The artificial practice mats/playing areas are also in play.
- Whilst the flags will remain in place on the short game area, please <u>DO NOT</u> touch the flagsticks at any time. The hole cups have also been raised to help retrieve golf balls.
- The centre section of the covered bays can be used for practice purposes.
- The rubber tees have been <u>REMOVED</u> from the artificial playing surfaces for now.
- Please hand sanitise <u>BEFORE</u> and <u>AFTER</u> using the practice area/range.

PLEASE STAY SAFE, ENJOY YOUR GOLF, SANITISE OFTEN AND FOLLOW ALL OF THE GUIDELINES WHILST USING THE PRACTICE AREA/RANGE.
