2022 World Hickory Open Championship



Anyone with an interest in the game will know just how far technology has improved the length and accuracy with which we can (sometimes) strike the ball but it hasn't always been this way. The Hickory golf is a variation of golf played with old-fashioned hickoryshafted golf clubs. There are active groups in the USA and Canada, throughout Europe

and, of course, in the UK that conduct national tournaments, as well as the World Hickory Open Championship.

Part of the attraction of playing with hickory clubs is that they reintroduce 'feel' to the golf shot. Proponents also claim that Hickory golf allows golfers to play classic golf courses as they are meant to be played and, as our Club is the 15th oldest club in the world, that has some resonance with us.

This October, a number of players from 14 different countries took part in the team and individual championship to compete for the Archie Baird Trophy. This unique competition was co-hosted by Fortrose and Rosemarkie Golf Club, together with Royal Dornoch Golf Club, Castle Stuart Golf Links and Nairn Golf Club. 104 players played in total at each venue and when we hosted the team championship on Monday 10th October 2022, the winning team came from Japan, with Sweden following a close second. The picture above shows the winning team who went on to be presented with the trophy at the Kingsmills Hotel at the official dinner/presentation night on Thursday 13th October.

Hickory golf cannot help but create memorable moments and the photograph below of Truls Anestam from Sweden taking the opening tee shot that day, gives a sense of the atmospheric memories that these teams will have taken home with them. We look forward to welcoming them all back soon.





WINTER TEES & BLUE POSTS/STAKES

Please note that the **blue posts/stakes** are now out on the course.

The winter tees are also currently in operation.

IF YOU WISH TO PLAY FROM INSIDE THE BLUE STAKED AREAS WHICH WILL BE CLEARLY MARKED BY THE GREENS STAFF ON EACH HOLE, THEN YOU MUST USE A MAT.

If you do not already own a mat, then they have been sourced by the club and can be purchased from the pro shop – price £12.00. Please note, we have **limited stock**.

PLEASE NOTE - the fairways, and in most cases the first cut of rough, really do need to be protected during the off-peak season.

News from the Greens team

WINTER PROGRAMME

Over these winter months, the Greens team will concentrate on 'revetting' of around ten greenside bunker faces. This will involve repairing some fairway bunker banks with a mix of revett and Marram grass planting for a more rugged and natural look. The aim is to reduce the need for continued revetting in years to come, as it is a very labour-intensive process and will free up time for other projects.

These projects include:

- Plant Marram in sections along 1st bank
- Slit tine aeration of fairways, tees and greens
- Whin bush management during inclement weather
- Install sprinklers to high wear walk on areas approaching 2nd and 3rd tees
- Turf over worn areas around course
- Build up a more natural mound back right of 7th green
- Add another sand scrape left hand side of 4th fairway
- Add a couple of natural swales either side of the 3rd fairway where the grass and contours are poor at present.
